

Estimating your Maritime Levy Payment: the first three years

Use the calculation table to estimate your new Maritime Levy Payment*. The calculation process has four steps. Follow Steps 1–4 to get six letters (A)–(F). Enter letters A–F into a Calculation Table.

(This calculation does not include the Oil Pollution Levy)

Calculation Table

- Once you have entered the figures into **A** to **F**, you can calculate the final column in the Calculation Table.
 - Multiply the figures in each row to produce the final column.
 - Then add up the three lines to calculate your estimated Maritime Levy Payment.

Note: The Calculation Table is an **estimate** of the Maritime Levy Payment and does not include the Oil Pollution Levy. If your vessel is Foreign, then the Maritime Levy is paid per port visit.

* The payment amount does not include GST. You will need to add GST.

First find out the GT or Length, Pax Cap and DWT for your vessel

- If you don't know the GT or Length, Pax Cap or DWT for your vessel, look at your Certificate of Survey. If you have DWT it is normally found in the Safety Construction Certificate for cargo ships.
- If you don't have a Certificate of Survey, you could look at your Certificate of Compliance, Safe Operational Plan or other similar document.
- If your vessel has more than one Pax Cap, **you must use the highest one.**

1 Work out which rates apply

You will need to know whether your vessel is a New Zealand or Foreign vessel.

New Zealand means:

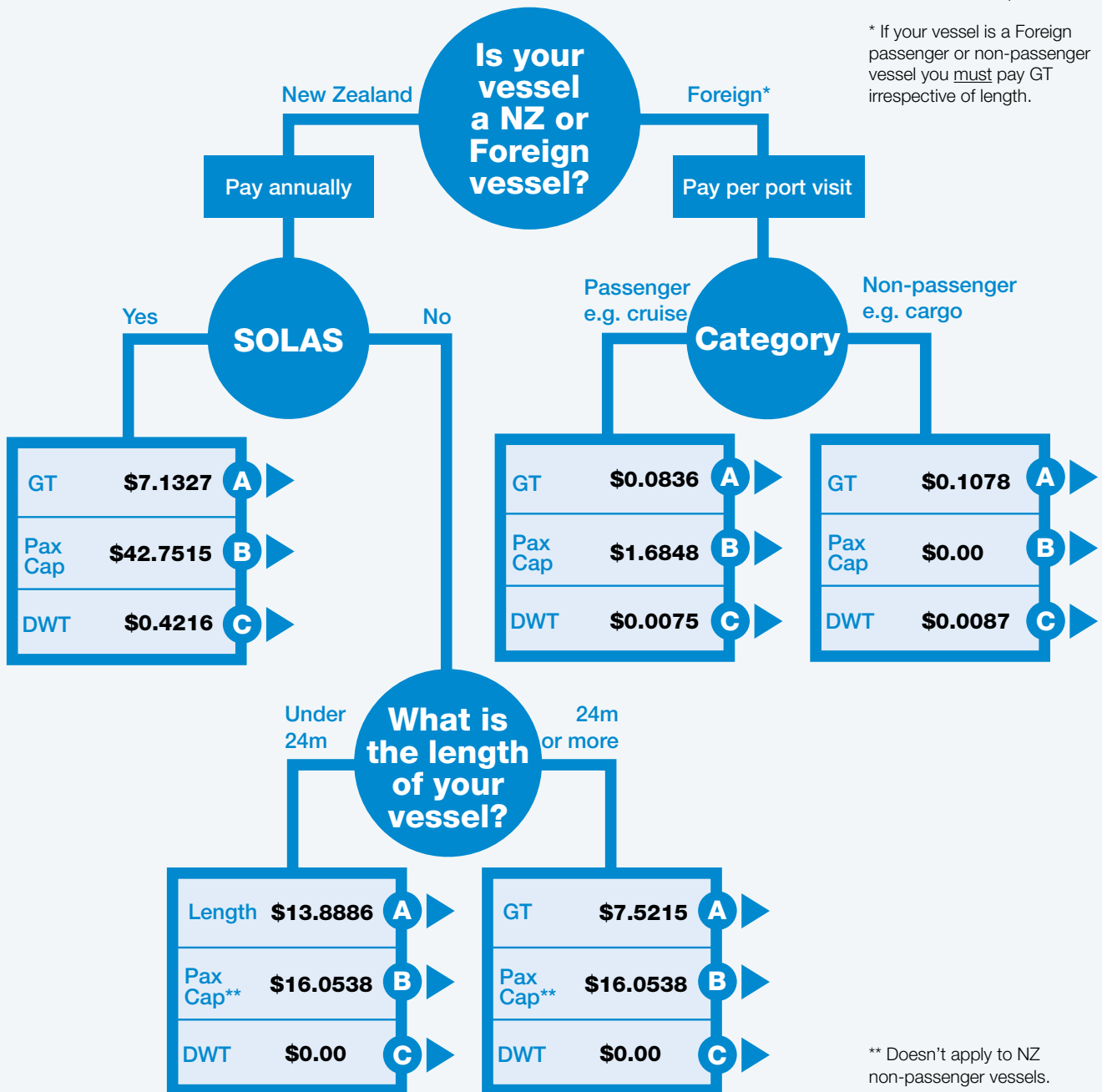
- New Zealand registered.
- Not New Zealand registered but required or entitled to be NZ registered.
- Registered in another country (foreign flagged) but on demise charter to NZ based operator.

Foreign means a vessel that is not a NZ vessel.

- 'Pax Cap' is passenger capacity, GT is gross tonnage, 'Length' is overall length in metres, 'DWT' is dead weight tonnage.

(SOLAS means Safety of Life At Sea convention).

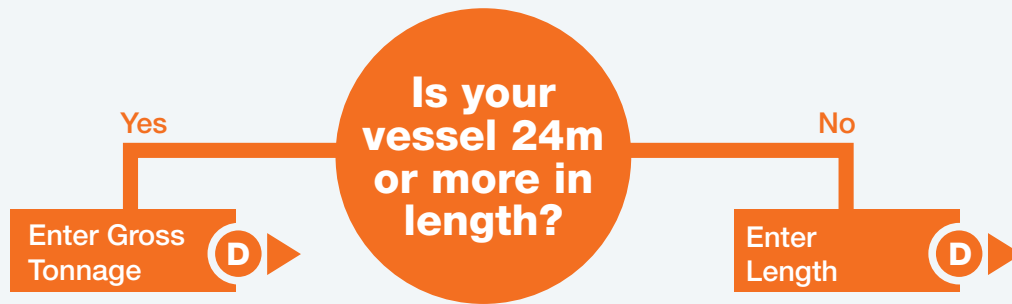
* If your vessel is a Foreign passenger or non-passenger vessel you must pay GT irrespective of length.



** Doesn't apply to NZ non-passenger vessels.

2 Work out if you pay on Length or Gross Tonnage

- Enter the Gross Tonnage (GT) figure into **D** in the Calculation Table. If your vessel is New Zealand non-SOLAS under 24 metres, then instead of Gross Tonnage (GT), you must enter the overall length of your vessel in metres into **D** into the Calculation Table.



3 Passenger Capacity (Pax Cap)

- Enter the Passenger Capacity into **E** in the Calculation Table.

Pax Cap is the maximum passengers the vessel can carry and does not include crew or staff on board.

Your vessel operating part-time /seasonally and not being full has already been assumed in the Pax Cap rate.



4 Dead Weight Tonnage

- If your vessel is NZ SOLAS or a foreign vessel, enter Dead Weight Tonnage (DWT) into **F** in the calculation table.
